- Souvenirs and gifts, on the ground floor.
- Bookshop, on the 2nd floor.
- Shops close 15 minutes prior to the Museum's closing time.

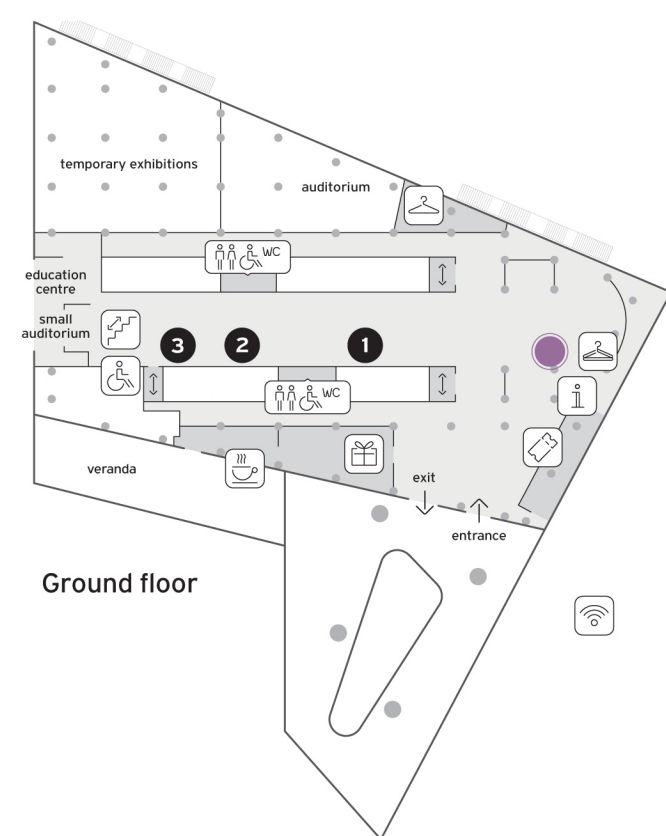
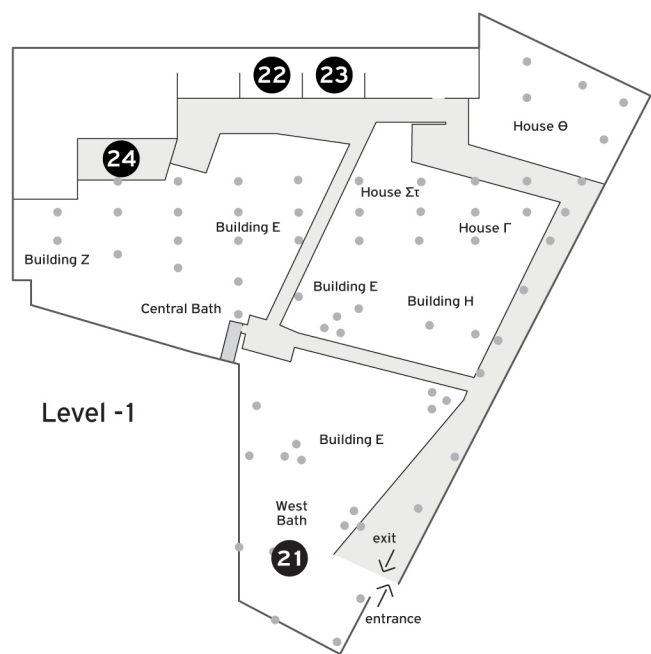

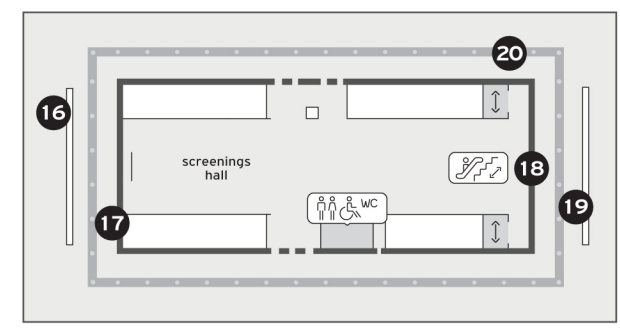
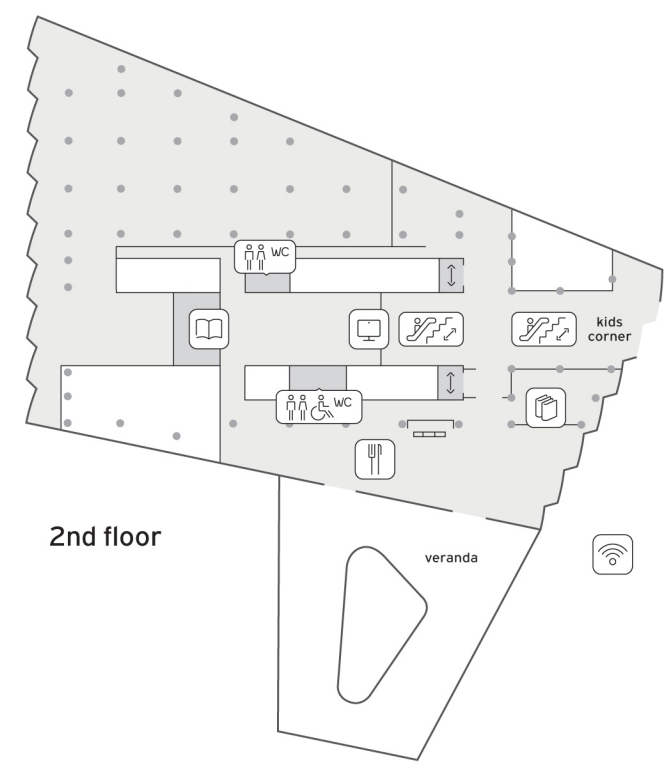
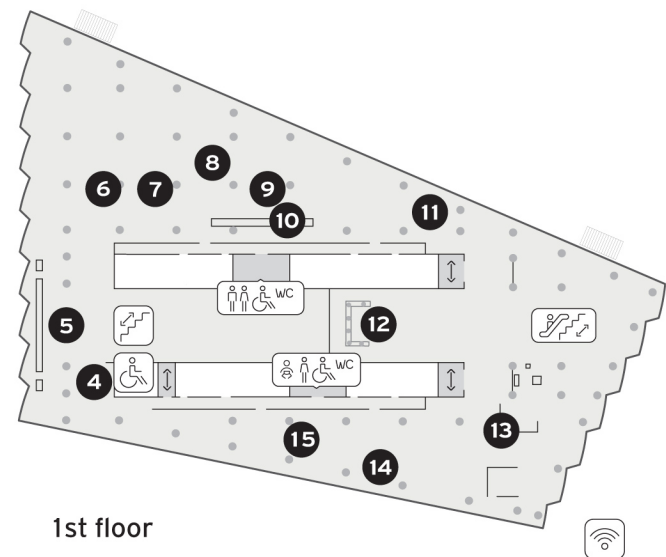

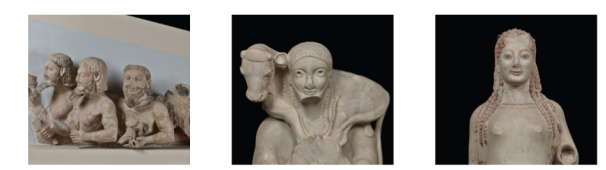
